Each person must wear a mask, and if you do not have one, we will have them available for purchase for \$1. Hand sanitizing stations are on premises for your convenience. The Old Log Jail will not be included in tours and this time, because of the confined space. Tours are \$3 Adults/\$1 for children. Buy a HCHS membership and get free tours for that membership for one year. Memberships are \$20 and we take Cash or Charge Cards via SQUARE.
